BRIEF BIO of MASTER FERRY

Master Greg Ferry started his training in the 1970s under the instruction of Grand Master Chung Eun Kim. In 1980 Master Ferry and Dr. Kevin Emge, who also studied under Master Kim, started the TaeKwon Do program at the Walnut Creek YMCA. In the early 1990s Master Ferry opened his own school, Central Iowa Martial Arts, and began a TaeKwon Do program at the Ankeny Family YMCA. He will soon be opening another school at the new Northwest YMCA in Grimes.

Master Ferry is currently a 7th degree Master of TaeKwon Do. He also holds a Black Belt in HapKi Do under Grand Master Ahn Eun Kim, and has been training in Brazilian Jiu Jitsu for over 12 years under the Gracies.

In addition to his rankings, Master Ferry has been awarded several honors. From 1986–2003 Master Ferry hosted The Early Bird Open, one of the first all style open martial arts tournaments in the Midwest. Master Ferry was a Nationally Ranked competitor through the late 1990s in forms, weapons and fighting. In 2006 Master Ferry was inducted into the World Karate Union Hall of Fame. He has taught at nationally recognized Martial Arts camps such as Martial Arts University and Karate College. Master Ferry has produced National Champions and has trained many MMA fighters over the past few years, some who have made it to the WEC and UFC.
